**RE: ACCEPTANCE AND APPROVAL OF DUST MANAGEMENT PLAN –
NOVEMBER 2020.**

The purpose of this correspondence is to acknowledge receipt and approval of Southern Quarries Pty Ltd's submission Dust Management Plan (ref 1529035-R-DMP-Rev10) dated November 2020 for the Sellicks Hill operation.

Southern Quarries is required under Licence Condition 1.1 'Dust Management Plan (U-390)' to develop, implement and comply with an EPA approved Dust Management Plan (DMP). Furthermore, Licence Condition 1.1.4 includes '...to require the licensee to revise the DMP to the satisfaction of the EPA and comply with the revised DMP.'

The EPA notes that the Dust Management Plan (rev10, November 2020) includes a future date of Q4 2023 for enclosure of the Tertiary Sand Open Stockpile, and as an interim measure the application of a mechanical rubber sock, to reduce drop height dust being produced, will be installed in Q1 2021. Should the Tertiary Sand Open Stockpile be identified as an ongoing source of excessive dust, the EPA may require a revision of the existing controls and proposed timeframes. However, subject to the aforementioned issue, the EPA hereby approves this current DMP (Rev10 November 2020).

In accordance with the requirement of Licence Condition (U-390) 'Dust Management Plan', Southern Quarries is hereby required under Licence Condition 1.1.2 to implement and

comply with the EPA approved DMP (Rev10, November 2020). Failure by Southern Quarries to comply with these requirements may result in further regulatory action.
